

Installation of Abacus

Abacus v1.2 is distributed as shareware (try-before-you-buy) software . When the installer completes its' work, run Abacus by clicking on the shortcut that will be placed on your desktop.

The first dialog that appears will offer you the chance to continue using the evaluation copy, enter a licence key, or to purchase Abacus through our website at www.witsendsolutions.co.uk. The program will allow you to run the software for 30 days, or on 15 separate occasions, whichever occurs first. This is to allow you to evaluate the program against your requirements before you purchase. Once purchased, you are entitled to free upgrades and bug-fixes up to but not including version 2.0.

If you have already purchased Abacus, enter your name and key EXACTLY as they were given to you by Wit's End Solutions Ltd. It may help to cut and paste the information from the email you received containing your registration details, but be careful that there are no leading or trailing spaces entered. When you have successfully entered your key, this dialog will not appear again.

The program will always ask for a password and username on starting, in order to protect the personal information it stores. The default password and username are both 'admin'. You should change these to something more personal as soon as possible, using the Options item on the main menu (File>Options). Remember that both are case sensitive - 'AbAcUs' is NOT the same as 'Abacus'. Both should also be memorable. Should you lose or forget either then please contact Wit's End Solutions for advice .
